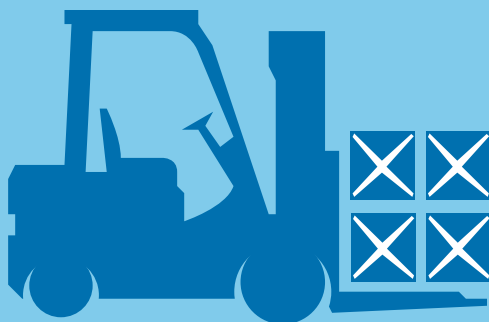
8 out of 10
